at (a) above have remained unfilled due to certain administrative reasons. Some of the vacancies have remained unfilled due to non-availability of suitable candidates even after the vacancies were circulated/re-circulated to all Central/State Government Departments and advertised in Employment News. Proposals to fill up some of the vacancies have already been sent to the UPSC/Staff Selection Commission. Efforts a're, being made to fill up these vacancies shortly.

Payment of arrears to bank employees towards revision of salary

1140. SHRI VISHWASRAO RAM-RAO PATIL: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have approved the agreement arrived at between the employees of the banks and the Indian Banks Association with regard to payment of arrears towards revision of salary;

(b) whether the banks have implemented the said agreement:

(c) whether it is a fact that the retired officers of the banks were also paid the arrears;

(d) whether the retired officers of the Bank of Baroda have not been paid arrears of gratuity, provident fund and leave encashment; and

(e) if so, what are the reasons therefor ?

MADHU DANDAVATE); (a) and (b) The service conditions, including the salary structure of the officers of the nationalised banks, are governed by the Officers' Service Regulations. Banks have been advised to make necessary amendments Regulations in these to incorporate the revised salary structures the basis of broad on understanding reached by the Indian Banks' Association with the representetive of the Officers. Pending amend-E E

ments to the Regulations, banks have been advised by the Indian Banks' Association to make adhoc payments to officers in the light of the revision of their salaries.

(c) to (e) The revised salary structure has been made effective from 1.11.1987 All the bank's officers retired on or after 1,11.1987 who are entitled to superannua. and tion benefits on the basis of revised scales of pay are eligible for arrears. While some of the banks have paid the arrears to their retired employees, others including Bank of Baroda, have not so far released the arrears, pending amendments to the relevant provisions of the Officers' Service Regulations
