THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT (SMT. MANEKA AND FORESTS GANDHI): (a) and (b) Nandadevi sanctuay was upgraded into a Nationοř al Park by Government Pradesh in 1980. The National Park area has now been included in the 1988. Biosphere Reserve formed in As per the management plan of Blosphere Reserve there will be complete ban on the entry of people and domestic animals in the core zone, i.e. National Park area except for the staff if Biosphere Reserve and authorised researchers. No request have been received by the Central Government to reopen the Nandadevi National Park.

(b) The main thrust of the strategy to contain the price rise and to ensure availability of essential commoproduction dities is to increase the particularly those which are in short supply. The procurement of items has been intensified. The public distribution system is being strengthened a part and parcel of overall process of planning and development. The imports of essential commodities like pulses, sugar and edible may be effected to augment the domestic availability of the commodities as and when necessary to check any abnormal rise in their prices. Resides price and availability monitoring mechanism is being strengthened, and the Essential Commodities Act and other regulatory measures would be strictly enforced.
