

(d) if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI P. V. NARASIMHA RAO): (a) Government have seen a report of a statement to this effect by the Deputy Prime Minister of Mauritius.

(b) to (d) Government have in all international fora consistently acknowledged Mauritian sovereignty over the Chagos Archipelago including Diego Garcia and called for its return to Mauritius. Government have associated themselves with the same position taken by the Non-aligned Movement. The Non-aligned Foreign Ministers' Conference held in Cyprus in September 1988 also expressed concern over the strengthening of the military base at Diego Garcia whose establishment has endangered the sovereignty, territorial integrity and peaceful development of Mauritius and other states. The Foreign Ministers called for the early return of Diego Garcia to Mauritius.

Creation of SAARC Fund
