THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPENDITURE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI B. K. GADHVI): (a) to (d) All proposals for foreign tours of Government Officers are examined carefully by the Screening Committee of Secretaries headed by the Cabinet Secretary before they are recommended to the Minister incharge of the administrative Department for final approval. Instructions have also been issued from time to time for ensuring utmost economy in the expenditure on travel inscluding foreign travel. Thee instructions envisage that Budget provision for travel should be split into external travel and internal travel and the expenditure under each of these items snould be regularly monitored. While examining proposals for deputation abroad, the justifications for the deputation is scrutinised from the essentiality angle and also taking into account the expenditure already incurred out of the Budget provision specifically earmarked for foreign travel. There had been no significant increase in the number of foreign tours during the last three years. Since the existing instructions and procedure for regulating deputation/delegation abroad ensure utmost economy in expenditure on foreign tours, there is no proposal to issue any fresh instructions in the matter.
