

(b) if so, the details thereof ;

(c) whether methodologies for forecasting plant diseases epidemics are being developed ; and

(d) if so, the details thereof; if not, the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI SHYAM LAL YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Evolution of tolerant/resistant crop varieties integrated pest management ensuring availability of fungicides, enforcing quarantine-regulations and strengthening extension efforts are the major steps taken by the Government to control plant diseases.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) Methodologies have been developed for forecasting onset of plant diseases and their epidemics by interpretation of epidemiological data in conjunction with significant environmental factors like temperature humidity, rainfall, sun shine cloudiness, etc. Air borne diseases like rusts of wheat are monitored by trap nurseries, spore traps and by mobile surveys. For other kind of diseases whether parameters are used for developing prognostic models.
