Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the National Thermal Power Corporation proposes to set up gas based power plants in Faridabad in Haryana to meet the growing power demand in the northern region;
- (b) if so, whether Government propose to lay a branch line of the HBJ pipeline to the site of the plant to meet the fuel requirements of the Project;
- (c) if so, what are the details thereof; and
- (d) by when the task is likely to be completed and to what extent the acute shortage of power in the northern region would be met?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI KALPNATH RAI): (a) to Feasibility Report for the setting up of a gas-based Combined Cycle power plant at Faridabad was submitted to the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) by the National Thermal Corporation (NTPC) in January, 1989. There are no approved proposals, at this stage, for the laying of a pipeline to Faridabad.

Details in regard to the implementation of the proposed project (800 MW) would be known after the scheme has been appraised by the CEA and investment decision has been taken in respect of the same.
