(a) and (b) Upto the Annual LPG Marketing Plan 1988-89, oil companies have proposals to set up four more LPG distributorships at Madurai and one each at Batlagundu and Kodaikanal District Madurai. There is, however, no proposal at present to set up any additional LPG distributorship in Ramanathapuram, Pasumpon Thevar, and Kamarajar Districts of Tamil Nadu;

(c) Under the present policy, reservation for various categories for award of distributorships/dealerships is done by the oil industry for the entire state and not on district-wise basis.
