(b) whether the proposal had earlier been submitted by the Bharat Heavy Electrical Ltd. also, if so, what are the constraints for not accepting their proposal; and :

(c) whether Government have explored the export potential of MBT, if so, the details thereof ?

Curtailing the Research Work of Regional Research Laboratory, Bhubaneswar

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRI K. R. NARAYANAN); (a) and (b) A news item had appeared in some newspaper alleging that the research work in forest, marine and agricultural resources in the Regional Research Laboratory, Bhubaneswar had been curtailed and throttled by the management though work had expanded a great deal in the sphere of minerals. The allegations are baseless. Research programmes of laboratories are formulated based on the recommendations of Research Council, Research Council of the Regional Research Laboratory, Bhubaneswar has identified areas of excellence for the laboratory as, under •

(i) Mineral beneficiation and agglomeration.

(ii) Extraction of non-ferrous metals.

(iii) Hydraulic transportation of minerals.

(iv) Plasma metallurgy.

The projects other than these are dovetailed to CSIR thrust area programmes or thrust area programme of other nodal laboratories.
