FACE TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) to (c) There is no such proposal with DTC at present. The DTC has intimated that the Roate No. 430 operating between Nehru Place Terminal and Kendriya Terminal has a frequency of 15/30 minutes during peak/lean hours, Nehru Place Terminal is well served by the present services on route No. 430.

Mid-day meals scheme for students in Kendriya Vidyalayas
