(b) if so, the details thereof, including the steps taken to create the required infrastructure and also for training the assigned personnel who would operate the reservation system?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) and (b) A proposal for selling of Tickets through Post Offices is under finalization in consultation with the Department of Post. Provision of infrastructure and training of personnel is part of the proposal.
