THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI BRAHM DUTT): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. these representations indicated shortage of Petrol and Petroleum Products in Darjeeling and the Oil Companies hare been directed to meet the genuine demands of these products.

Deferment of Blinker System for Two Wheelers

- (a) how many two-wheeler manufacturers have represented to his Ministry for recommending deferment of the provision requiring blinker system in all two wheelers under the New Motor Vehicle Rules;
- (b) whether it is a fact that one ofthe representations is by M/s. Bajaj Auto Limited, which has sought deferment of this provision on the ground of inadequate manufacturing facilities of the blinker system;
- (e) whether the Ministry in reoommendig the deferment considered that M/s- Bajaj Auto Ltd. have been providing their various models with and without blinker system and also as an accessory for the last many years;
- (d) whether it is a fact that most of the components required for blinker system are being manufactured by small, medium and ancillary industries which have sufficient capacity to meet the total requirement of the industry and on whom most ofthe manufacturers rely for their requirements; and
- (e) if the answers to parts (c) and (d) above be in the affirmative, what arethe reasons for this deferment?

THE MINISTER OF INDUS* TRY (SHRT J. VENGAL RAO): (a) and (b) Representations have been received from the Assocaatioa of Indian Automobile Manufacturers and three manufacturers of two-wheeler seeking lead time for the enforcement of the provisions relating to fitment bfminker system

in two-wheelers under the provisions of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989. One of the representation has been made by M/s. Bajaj Auto Limited who have sought lead time fer complying with this provision to enable them to carry modifications on their vehicles for incorporating the blinker system and' for developing sources of supply foi this system.

(c) to (e) Provision of blinker system in a vehicle not only involves developing sources of supply components but also modifications of the vehicle for fitting this system. Besides, design and technical parameters -of blinkers system is notunifrom for allcategories of two-wheelers The auto-ancillary industry would certainly need some timet gear up to meet the substantial. additional demand in the wake of the enforcement of the new Motor Vechicles Rules. The Ministry of Industry has carefully considered all aspects of the matter and are of the view that reasonable time should be allowed to the manufacturers of two-wheelers and the auto ancillary industry to suitably organise thier production factfitie's before enforcing the relevant

- (c) if, what was the production of ep ch drug of each producer from the 1st January, 1980 to the 31st December, 1987?
