INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM): (a) Ashok Paper Mills have two units one at Jogighope in Assam and other at Rameshwaranagar in Bihar. The Paid up Capital of Ashok Paper Mills as on 31-12-86 is 509.61 lakhs (both Equity & Preference share capital). The shareholding pattern is broadly as follows:

- 1. Gn vn.ront of Assam 31 p;r cent
- 2. Gwynrmntof Bihar 16 per cent
- 3. Public FinanC.al Ins-48.5 per c:nt titutions
- 4. Promat -rs. Associates 4.5 per cent and Public.
- (b) The Jogighope unit has been lying closed since March, 1983.
- (c) Central Government have informed the Assam State Government that it is the responsibility of the State Government to reopen and revive the Ashok Paper Mills. The Central Government has offered to provide necessary assistance to the Government of Assam for the reopening of the Ashok Paper Mills, including the technical and managerial expertise of the Hindustan Paper Corporation.

On a reference made by the Company in June, 1987 the Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction has declared Ashok Paper Mills as a Sick Industrial Gompany in terms of the Sick Industrial Companies (Special Provisions) Act, 1985 and has initiated necessary proceedings under the Act

From 1983 to 1989 (upto June), 12 letters of Intent and 1 Industrial Licence have been issued. 2 De-licensed Industries Registration (DLR) in 1987 and 1 DLR in 1988 have also been issued.
