Point 20 of the Twenty Point Programme—1986 aims at a more responsive administration. Towards this end, a large number of steps have been taken. Ministries and Departments of the Central Government, as well as agencies working within their jurisdiction, have taken steps for simplification Of rules and procedures with a view to cutting-down avoidable delays and eliminating the scope of harassment for the common man, in making decisions and their implementation. These are also intended to demystify the processes of administration," particularly at the levels which interact directly with the citizen. They have also strengthened their machinery for redressal of public grievances, There is a Grievance Officer for every Ministry and Department. All these offices have a day-in the week designated as a meetingless day when senior officers receive and attend to public grievances. Ministries and Departments have also been ins> tructed to ensure that every officer deals with every issue in a fair, objective arid just manner.
