

Grants to voluntary organisations for tribal women

1314. SHRI M.V. MYSURA REDDY: Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether financial grants are being released to voluntary organizations running education centres for tribal women in the different parts of the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by Government to provide grants in time, State-wise; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI P.R. KYNDIAH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Ministry has been implementing a Central Sector Scheme, namely "Educational Complex in Low Literacy Pockets for Development of Women Literacy in Tribal Areas", for promotion of education amongst tribal girls in 136 identified low literacy districts, as per 1991 census, and areas belonging to the primitive tribal groups. The scheme is implemented through Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and autonomous societies of the State Governments. Under the scheme, 100% Central Assistance is given for setting up of educational complexes with free schooling, boarding and lodging facilities for tribal girls. The details of funds released to NGOs and autonomous societies under the scheme during the last three years, in each State, are given in Statement. (See below)

To ensure release of the grants in time, all the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations are requested to submit proposals of NGOs in all schemes, including the instant scheme, by April-May of every year. On receipt of complete proposals from the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations, the Ministry processes the cases for release of grants under schemes expeditiously.
