When will These projects be cleared ?

SHRI VASANT SATHE: For coal-based plants, the basic requirement is coal-linkage. Unless you first assure coal-linkage, we cannot clear the project. on what are you going to set up the project? Merely sending the proposal and saying that you want to set up a coal-based thermal power units units does not help us. The State Government must also tell us whether they have got coal-linkage. If you can persuade the Government of Maharashtra to secure coal-linkage, we will be able to clear the projects without any delay.
