

(d) what has been the progress in discussions with regard to L.C.A. particularly about purchases of composites by wire technology and co-development of such technology ?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRIK. C. PANT): (a) Recent visit of RM to USA is expected to lead to a better appreciation of India's security concerns, contribute to improved understanding between the two countries and facilitate mutually beneficial bilateral cooperation.

(b) The defence cooperation between the two countries is at an initial stage. Exploratory discussions are continuing to step up defence cooperation.

(c) Progress under the on-going LOA programme has been generally satisfactory. Exploratory discussions were held on the possibility of cooperation in Under Water Technology.

(d) In discussions regarding the LCA Programme, clarifications were given in regard to India's aeronautics technology absorption plans via co-development in areas like digital fly-by-wire and the requirement of composites for the LCA was highlighted.
