THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI SONTOSH MOHAN DEV): (a) and (b) It has been agreed by the managements of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) under the administrative control of Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas that the Boards of Directors of these CPSEs may consider relief in terms of performance related payments to their Officers within the guidelines of Department of Public Enterprises (OPE).

(c) and (d) Performance Related Payments within the provisions of DPE guidelines dated 25.6.99 and 27.3.2000 may be provided by the management of profit making CPSEs.

Revival of loss making PSUs

1429. SHRI RAHUL BAJAJ: Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Public Sector Units which are in continuous losses for the last three years, their names, extent of losses, extent of budgetary support provided, total capital employed and the number of employees; and

(b) the details of action proposed to stop this gross waste of tax payers' money?

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI SONTOSH MOHAN DEV): (a) Based on Public Enterprises Survey 2004-05, the latest period for which information is available, during last three years i.e. in 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 there were 54 continuous loss making Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). The names of these CPSEs along with extent of losses, budgetary support provided, total capital employed and number of employees is enclosed as Statement (See below).

(b) Government has constituted a Board for Reconstruction of Public Sector Enterprises (BRPSE) in December, 2004 to undertake the task of study and analysis of the possibility for strengthening, modernizing, reviving, and restructuring of loss making CPSEs.
