current sugar season 1988-89 (October '88-September, '89)  $i_s$  estimated to be about 87.0 lakh tonnes as against the production of 91.10 lakh tonnes and the consumption, of 93.33 lakh tonnes, during the previous season. In view of this, export of sugar has been restricted to preferential Quota (USA 8424 tonnes, EEC 10,000 tonnes) and export ot 15,000 tonnes to Nepal. Further export of sugar, if any, would depend upon availability of sugar after meeting internal requirements.
