(b) if so, what plan Government are envisaging to benefit the farmers by adopting latest inventions in the agricultural field?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AND EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HARI KRISHNA SHASTRI):

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) There are extension systems to disseminate agricultural technologies to the farmers. They mainly consist of the Training and Visit system of the Ministry of Agriculture, and the First-Line Extension projects of the I.C.A.R. These first line extension projects, are, National Demonstrations Project (NDP), Operational Research Projects (ORPs), Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs), Lab-to-Land Programme (LLP), ORP for Tribal Areas and ORP on Socio-Economic Upliftment of Scheduled Castes and Backward Communities.

#### Steps for betterment of slum dwellers

2699. SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the convention of the slum dwellers in Delhi called for a comprehensive policy on slums for their economic opportunities, education, civic amenities and primary health care; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) Government is not aware of any such convention

(b) For improving the quality of life of slum dwellers in Delhi basic amenities as 'pay and use' Jansuvidha Com-

plexes, water supply including drinking water taps, sewer, storm water drains, widening & pavement of existing streets, street lighting etc. are being provided under the Environmental Improvement Programme.

#### Modernisation of steel plants in the country

(a) whether Government have formulated a plan for modernisation of Steel Plants in the country; and

(b) if so, the details thereof

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI MAKHAN LAL FOTEDAR): (a) and (b) Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) have formulated schemes for modernisation of its steel plants. Government have already approved the scheme for modernisation of Durgapur Steel Plant at an estimated cost of Rs. 2667.6 crores. This scheme is likely to be implemented in 4 years time. Details of other schemes would be known when the proposals come up for investment Decisions.
