- (a) whether Government are aware of the existence of Bhima Shankar Mahadev Dwadas Jyotirling at Dakani Hills 15 km. away from Guwahati;
- (b) whether Government are considering any scheme for beautification of this place of religious and historical importance by constructing a temple there;
- (c) whether it would lead to rise in the number of tourists visiting Assam and the revenue earning is likely to increase; and
- (d)if so, by when the repair of roads leading to the said place and work related to beautification is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH-EASTERN REGION (SHRI MANI SHANKAR AIYAR): (a) According to the Government of Assam, there is an archaeological site at Dakani Pahar containing stone architectural relics datable to the 11th century A. D. approximately. The site has a Siva Linga measuring about 10" in height. The site is located in village Pamahi under Mouza-Ramsarani, circle, office-Mirza, Bibck-Rani under Garbhanga Reserve Forest of Kamrup District. The site is locally known as Sri Pasdhara Bhimeswar Siva Dham. But it is yet to be confirmed

whether this site is the Bhima Sankar Dwadas Jyotirlinga. The site is not a protected monument under the control of the Archaeological Survey of India.

- (b) The State Government has not yet taken up the development of this site.

- (d) The State Government has informed the Ministry that the development of the roads can be taken up subject to the availability of funds.
