(a) the number of posts of Yoga teachers sanctioned for Kendriya Vidyalaya, Bhutan during the current and preceding academic sessions;

(b) the reasons that prompted Kendriya Vidyalayas Sangathan to transfer Yoga teachers of that School;

(c) whether Kendriya Vidyalayas of Agra and Mathura fall within the administrative jurisdiction of Jaipur region; and

(d) if not, what are the reasons for authorising the Assistant Commissioner, Jaipur to transfer vacant posts of Yoga teachers to Kendriya Vidyalayas in Mathura and Agra from Jaipur region?

(b) The school is to close w.e.f. 30-4-89. The teacher was transferred on 22-12-88 as the school was to close from 23-12-88 to 9-2-89 for winter vacation. The services of yoga Teacher were not required as there were very few students in classes VI to X.

(d) Assistant Commissioner, Jaipur Region has been authorised by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan to transfer vacant posts and yoga teachers among Kendriya Vidyalayas in his region.
