(d) The Delhi Prohibition of Eve-teasing Bill, 1984	2 hrs.
3. Consideration and passing of the following Bills, as passed by the Lok Sabha :—	
(a) The Monopolies and Restrictive Trade Practices (Amendment) Bill, 1988	2 hrs.
(b) The Banking Public Financial Institution and Negotiable Instruments Laws (Amendment) Bill, 1988	3 hrs.
4. Discussion on the Thirty-fifth, Thirty-sixth and Thirty-seventh Reports of the Union Public Service Commission	4 hrs.
