

4. For improvement of Science Education, 557 High/Higher Secondary Schools are being provided with Laboratory equipment and science books. Science kits are being supplied to 1669 upper primary schools.

5. Under Rural Functional Literacy Project, Jan Shikshan Nilayams are being set up and books, magazines and dailies are being provided to the Nilayams.

**Talks with Bangladesh regarding Flood control Measures**

3183. SHRI SHIV PRATAP MISHRA: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether an Indian delegation visited Bangladesh on 18th November, 1988 to hold talks on long term and short term flood control measures;

(b) if so, what are the details of discussions held between the two countries; and

(c) what is the outcome thereof?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI P. V. NARASIMHA RAO): (a) to (c) The Indo-Bangladesh Task Force met in Dhaka from November 18 to 20. During the meeting the task force held detailed discussions and agreed on the work programme and time-frame for completing the task. The task force identified the short term and long-term areas of cooperation for formulating structural and non-structural measures for flood management.

**Enhancing the age of Retirement of Delhi School Teachers**
