(d) and (e) There is no proposal for exclusively assisting Orthopaedically handicapped beggars under the Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fitting of AIDS/Appliances (ADIP) Scheme. However under ADIP Scheme, needy disabled persons are assisted in procuring aids/appliances that can promote their physical, social and psychological rehabilitation by reducing the effects of disabilities and to enhance their economic potential.

Social security system for elderly
