Shifting of Gymkhana Club

945. SHRI SHIV PRATAP MISHRA: Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to shift Delhi Gymkhana Club and use the space for building houses for V.I.P.s; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT

(SHRI DALBIR SINGH): (a) and (b) A Working Group constituted by the Ministry of Urban Development has made certain redevelopment proposals which *inter alia* involve change of land-use of the Area under Delhi C. Gymkhana Club. The Government has not taken any view on these recommendations and hence there is no proposal at the moment to shift the Delhi Gymkhana Club.

Discovery of new deposits of bentonite in Bihar

946. SHRI SHIV PRATAP MISHRA: Will the Minister of STEEL AND MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether huge deposits of bentonite have been discovered in Bihar; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI M. L. FOTEDAR): (a) and (b) A reserve of 12.86 Million Tonnes of Bentonite in Bihar comprising of 6 Million Tonnes in Sahebganj district and 6.86 Million Tonnes in Santhal Parganas has been estimated recently.

Affairs of ICAR

947. SHRI SHIV PRATAP MISHRA: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item which appeared in the 'Hindustan Times' of the 14th September, 1988 under the caption 'I.C.A.R. scientists demoralised' regarding affairs of the I.C.A.R.; and

(b) if so, the steps taken by Government to remove the grievances of the scientists?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AND EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HARI KRISHNA SHASTRI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b)(i) Government have decided to adopt the University Grants Commis-

sion's scales of pay for the scientists engaged in teaching, research and extension in the ICAR system.

(ii) Government have completed the examination of the recommendations of the C. V. K. Rao Committee. The IARI has prepared specific guidelines for approval of research projects by the Research Council of the Institute.

Implementation of 20 Point Programme in relation to Welfare of SC and ST

948. SHRIMATI SUDHA VIJAY JOSHI : Will the Minister of WELFARE be pleased to state :

(a) whether the implementation of the 20 Point Programme in relation to the welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes people is being reviewed and drawbacks in the same have been noticed;

(b) whether the programme is being revised with a view to make it more result-oriented and see that more practical benefits flow to economically downtrodden people; and

(c) if so, the details thereof ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WELFARE (SHRIMATI SUMATI ORAON) : (a) The progress under Point II "Justice to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes" under 20-Point Programme in relation to welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes is being reviewed through monthly and quarterly progress reports received from States/UTs implementing Special Component Plans for Scheduled Castes and Tribal Sub-Plans for Scheduled Tribes. Wherever drawbacks in progress in relation to targets are noticed, the same are brought to the notice of implementing States/UTs for immediate remedial steps.

(b) and (c) The restructured 20-Point Programme is result-oriented. It aims at removal of handicaps and impediments in the path of growth and development of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes so as to bring them at par with rest of the society. The programme aims at :

(i) compliance with the Constitutional provisions and laws for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;

(ii) possession of land allotted to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;

(iii) revitalisation of the land allotment programme;

(iv) organising and assisting special coaching programmes to improve educational standards;

(v) eradicating scavenging and undertaking special programmes for the rehabilitation of Safai Karamcharis;

(vi) provide better direction and adequate funds for the Special Component Programmes;

(vii) pursuance of programmes for the fuller integration of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes with the rest of the society; and

(viii) rehabilitation of tribals displaced from their habitats.

Enquiry in almonds stock case of NCCF

949. SHRI PUTTAPAGA RADHA-KRISHNA : Will the Minister of FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state :

(a) whether an Assistant Manager II in NCCF was placed under suspension in February/March, 1980 for committing serious bungling with NCCF's stocks while working as Incharge of Lawrence Road godown;

(b) whether it is a fact that there were 5 charges against the officer and he was let off merely on a warning on one of the charges;

(c) whether it is also a fact that one of the charges was not pursued by the Presenting Officer;

(d) whether it is also a fact that vital documents/witnesses were not produced before the Enquiry Officer on another charge and the Enquiry Officer had commented about the charged officer's suspicious role and his possible involvement
