- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the details of the proposal relating to the extent of augmentation in power generation capacity after renovation of these plants and the amount allotted for this purpose?

THE MINISTER OF POWER (SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR SHINDE): (a) to (d) Yes, Sir. The Government of India has programmed the revival of Baruani Thermal Power Station (TPS) Units 4 & 5 (2x50 MW) and Kanti (Muzaffarpur) TPS Units 1 & 2 (2x110 MW) and Renovation and Modernization (R&M) of Barauni TPS Units 6 & 7 (2x110 MW) with the involvement of Government of Bihar, Bihar State Electricity Board (BSEB), NTPC Ltd. and Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd. (BHEL). Planning Commission has already released Rs. 75 crores against an estimated cost of Rs. 506 crore to M/s. BHEL to take up the work for Barauni Units 6 & 7 and Muzaffarpur TPS Units 1 & 2 under Rashtriya Sam Vikas Yojana (RSVY). BSEB and NTPC Ltd. have formed a Joint Venture named "Vaishali Power Generating Company Ltd." to run Muzaffarpur TPS. Order for revival of both units have been placed on BHEL. Technical specification for Residual Life Assessment/Conditional Assessment/Performance Evaluation Test of Barauni Units 4 & 5 has been submitted by NTPC to BSEB, NTPC Ltd, has also submitted the scope of work with cost estimates for Restoration of Unit 5 to BSEB on 10.07.2006. After carrying out revival/R&M works on the units, the units are expected to operate with full output during 11th Plan.

- (a) the number of professional institutes, imparting higher education in technology, engineering, architecture, agriculture, management, etc. in the country; separately in private (aided and unaided) and Government sector, seat capacity, State-wise;
- (b) whether reservation of seats for SC/ST and OBCs is not available in unaided private professional institutes;

- (c) if so, details thereof;
- (d) whether Government proposes to amend the Constitution of India to provide for such reservation; and
 - (e) if so, details, thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) Relevant information, as maintained Centrally, is given in the Statement-I, Statement-II and Statement-III (See below).

(b) to (e) A legislative proposal for providing reservations in unaided educational institutes coming under the purview of Central Government is under the consideration of the Government. After the 93rd Amendment to the Constitution of India, Clause (5) in Article 15 of the Constitution, enables making special provisions by law, for the advancement of the weaker sections in so far as such special provisions relate to their admission to all educational institutions, including aided or unaided private educational institutions, other than minority educational institutions established under Article 30(1) of the Constitution. The reservation of seats for weaker sections in admission to unaided professional institutes under the purview of the State Governments depends on the policy of that State Government.
