The reasons for undei utilisation as given by the State Govt, are (i) Resource crunch due to drought (ii) In case of Energy, set back in generation due to drought and set back ia power generation due to mechanical problems of certain machinery and (iii) in case of General Economic Services fund J diverted to other needy sectors. Shortfall under the other three sectors are marginal. Statement of sector-wise revised approved outlay and likely expendi-ture is enclosed.
