THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DE-VELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENER-GY, ELECTRONICS AND SPACE (SHRI K. R. NARAYANAN) : (a) Yes, Sir. Shri Babu Matheu, a Keralite youth, has claimed to have achieved success in producing synthetic petrol.

(b) CSIR scientists have been as Iced to verify the claim and examine the product.

Assistance to Orissa Government of Social Security Scheme

THE MINISTER OF PLANN-ING AND THE MINISTER OF PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTA-TION (SHRI MADHAVSINH SOLANKI); (a) The financial assistance from the Centre to the Government of Orissa for the State Plans Schemes is given as block grant.

(b) and (c) The major Social Security Schemes being undertaken or proposed to be undertaken by the Centre for weaker sections in the country including Orissa are

(i) Personal Aceident Insurance Social Security Scheme,

(ii) Hut Insurance Scheme, for poor families in rural areas,

(iii) Group Insurance Scheme for Landless Agricultural Labourers.

Many poor families in Orissa would benefit from these schemes.

Projects under implementation in Orissa

4308. SHRI SUBAS MOHANTY: Will the Ministery of PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleaed to state :

fa) what are the centrally sponsorec engineering projects under implementation in Orissa :

(b) whether the delay in completion cf those projects is leading to cost esc; lrtion; and

(c) if so, the details of steps taken to expedite the execution of thos e projects ? THE MINISTER OF PLAN-NING AND THE MINISTER OF PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTA-TION (SHRI MADHAVSINH SOLANKI): (a) According to the Ouarterly Monitoring System of the Ministry of Programme Implementation as on 31-3-1988, in respect of projects costing over Rs. 20 crores each, there are no Engineering Projects falling under Heavy, Medium and Light Engineering, under implementation in Orissa.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

Money Allotted to Orissa

4309. SHRI SUBAS MOHANTY Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state

(a) the total money allocated to Orissa for annual plan for 1987-88 and the amount of money utilised by the State Government; and

(b) the sector where the money could not be utilised and the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF PLAN-NING AND THE MINISTER OF PROGRAMME IM?LEM3NTA-TION (SHRI MADHAVSINH SOLANKI) : (a) Approved outlay for the Annual Plan 1987-88 for the State of Orissa is Rs. 74202 lakhs against which the likely expenditure is Rs. 69593-12 lakhs.

(b) Outlay is not likely to be fully utilised und ir tha sectors of Rural Development, Irrigation and Flood Control, Energy, General Economic Services and Social Services. The reasons for undei utilisation as given by the State Govt, are (i) Resource crunch due to drought (ii) In case of Energy, set back in generation due to drought and set back ia power generation due to mechanical problems of certain machinery and (iii) in case of General Economic Services fund J diverted to other needy sectors. Shortfall under the other three sectors are marginal. Statement of sector-wise revised approved outlay and likely expendi-ture is enclosed.
