**International Fund for Agricultural Development**

799. SHRI K. V. THANGKABALU: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state;

(a) whether the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) proposes to assist some projects in Orissa and other States;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether it is a fact that some projects have already been implemented in the country;

(d) if so, what are the locations of each such project;

(e) what are the details of assistance obtained for those projects.; and

(f) how many projects are being implemented or proposed to be implemented in Tamil Nadu?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI EDUARDO FALEIRO): (a) and (b) The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) has extended a loan of US \$ 12.2 million for a Tribal Development Project in Orissa through an agreement signed on 4-2-1988. The Project is located in Kasipur Block of Koraput District and is intended to achieve a Bustainable economic up liftment of the tribal population in the area, through investments in agricultural production, rural infrastructure, natural resource development and human resource development.

(c) to (e) Details of assistance obtained from IFAD for other projects and the States in which they are located are as follows:—

**Indo-Yugoslav Trade Agreement**

801. KUMARI SUSHILA TIPIA: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state;

(a) whether it is a fact that Indo-Yugoslav trade agreement has been led recently to raise trade turnover; and

(b) if so, what are the salient features of the agreement?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI P. R. DAS MUNSHT): (a) and (b) A protocol of the talks held during the

17th Session of the Indo-Yugoslav Joint Committee for Economic Cooperation in New Delhi from June 17—21, 1988 was signed on 21st June, 1988. The salient features of the Protocol are given below:—

(i) It was agreed that for 1988, both Sides would make efforts to reach a level of trade turnover of US \$ 250 million on a balanced basis.

(ii) Both sides agreed to promote growth of trade through link deal mechanism and through trade flows taking place outside the link deal mechanism on a balanced basis.

(iii) It was agreed to sign long term contracts on items of interests to the two Sides.

(iv) It was agreed to extend the existing link deal arrangement signed in August, 1984 for a further period of two years beyond 30-9-83 and to expand the basket of commodities exchanged under this arrangement.

(v) The two Sides agreed that considerable scope exists for industrial cooperation particularly in the areas like agricultural machinery, automobile industry, machine tools, energy, electronics, railways, ship building, alumina-silicate complexes, agro-chemical handtools, food processing industries, telecommunication, civil construction, fishing boats and projects in third countries.

(vi) Both sides agreed for further cooperation in the fields of finance and banking, shipping, planning, tourism and science and technology.
