**Arrest of Retired Naval Officers at Bombay**

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether a retired officer of the Indian Navy was arrested at Bombay's Sahar International Airport on May 31, 1988 on the charge of smuggling of vital defence papers out of the country; and

(b) if so, what are the details of the incident and what steps have been taken by Government to prevent leakage of vital defence secrets?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. CHIDAMBARAM): (a) and (b) A former Indian Naval Officer was arrested at Bombay on May 30, 1988 while leaving for New York by an Air India flight. Some documents were recovered following a search of his booked passage. A case u/s 3 of the Official Secrets Act was registered against him at Sahar Police Station, Bombay on the same day.

A number of steps have been taken to ensure the security and secrecy of classified documents in the various Ministries, and Deptts. These include streamlining of security procedures relating to treatment and handling of

all classified information, tightening of security arrangements in Government Office buildings etc.
