THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI SAROJ KHAPAR-DE): (a) The Government have launched an extensive programme for screening persons of high risk groups and for this purpose surveillance centres have been established in Tamil Nadu as under:--

- -Madras Medical College, Madras,
- -Institute of Child Health, Madras.
- -Madurai Medical College, Madurai.
- -Apollo Hospital Madras
- -Jipmer, Pondicherry.

An AIDS Cell with an officer-in-charge has also been established at the Siate Health Headquarters to coordinate the activities and to assist the centres in collection of Sera Samples from high risk group and follow up case.
