THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MA-DHAVRAO SC1NDIA): (a) Improvements to railways stations in the form of provision of basic amenities is expected to be completed by 1990-91. Other improvements, including provision of additional amenities as found necessary at important stations will also be progressed side by side, depending on availability of resources. Four stations in Tamil Nadu^ viz., Madras Centra Coimbatore, Tiruchira-palli and Madurai have been selected for being developed as model stations.

(b) 62 stations as per list Statement-I annaxed have so far been improved during; the Seventh Five Year Plan period. (See below).

(c) 39 stations as per list Statement-H are proposed to be improved during the remaining period of the Seventh Five Year Plan.
