

Emergency Response Committee has been set up by the Department of Atomic Energy to deal with emergency situations in the nuclear installations. This Committee ensures that emergency procedures and action plans are prepared by the State concerned in consultation with the Nuclear Installation Authorities to safeguard the public in the event of an emergency occurring in any of the nuclear installations. Such plans have been prepared in respect of the nuclear power stations at Tarapur, Rajasthan, Kalpakkam and also for the Narora Atomic Power Project under construction. In order to test the emergency preparedness, regular drills are carried out. Two emergency "Off-Site" exercise in the public domain have been conducted, one at Kalpakkam and the other at Rajasthan.

**Acquisition of Airborne/Elevated Radars by Pakistani Air Force**

(a) whether Government are aware of the fact that Pakistan is acquiring air-borne/elevated radars and inflight refuelling system to give PAF superiority over IAF with capacity to "see" and to strike much deeper besides making its airforce capable of effecting large number of interceptions with only limited fighting force;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether Government have studied the implications and the threat to the country's security as a result thereof; and

(d) if so, what steps are contemplated by Government to strengthen the country's air defence to meet any eventuality?
