THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SHRIPRAKASH JAISWAL): (a) Number of persons (civilians & security personnel) killed by the naxalites in Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand during the last two years are as under:—

(b) As per available reports, naxalites possess sophisticated weapons like SLRs, carbines, AK-series rifles and a few LMGs and INSAS rifles and other arms including. 303,.410 muskets, revolvers/pistols mostly snatched or looted from police/security forces as well as regular and country-made weapons of various makes and calibers. CPI (Maoist) is also reported to have improvised rockets and grenade launchers as well as anti-personnel/ vehicle landmines.

(c)As per the information provided by the Government of Jharkhand, in the last three years, about 150 boys and girls joined naxalites, of whom about 25 joined from Simdega and Gumla districts.
