strongly emphasised the need for the strict implementation of the Geneva accords.

- (b) It i_S our impression that international opinion i_S in favour of the observance of the Geneva accords.
- (c) Government will continue to lend support to the Geneva accords.

Unemployment situation in States and Union Territories

1147. SHRI NARESH C. PUGLIA: Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government have conducted any study on the unemployment situation in State and Union Territory-wise including the number of educated and uneducated unemployed;
- (b) if so, what are the details of the study report; and
 - (c) if the answer to part (a) above

be in the negative the reasons therefor?

MINISTER OF PLANNING THE THE MINISTER OF PRO-GRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI MADHAVSINH SOLANKI): (a) Yes, Sir. The National Sample Organisation (NSSO), Department of Statistics conducts a quinquennial survey on employment and unemployment, in the course of which data is also collected about the educational level of the employed or unemployed persons. The latest survey was carried out in the National Sample Survey (NSS) 43 rd round (July 1987-June 1988).

- (b) Data from the latest survey of which the field work was completed only in June, 1988 are still under processing. The results based on the preceding survey conducted in the NSS 38th round (January—December, 1983) are enclosed. (See Statement below).
- (c) Not applicable in view of reply to Part (a) above.

1148 SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AF-FAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether it is a fact that the terrorists who were claiming to be Khalistan Organisation members have been patronised in Britain and they are getting all assistance from Britain for their terrorist activities in India; and
- (b) if so, whether the Government of India has taken up the issue with the British Government to stop their activities in helping terrorists of Punjab?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI K. NATWAR SINGH): (a) There is no evidence to

suggest that 'Khalistani' organisations are "getting assistance from Britain for their terrorist activities in India," however it is a fact that since mid-1984 anti-Indian activity by 'Khalistani' extrimists in the U.K. markedly increased. Several anti-Indian extremits organisations in London reactivated themselves and have been indulging in anti-Indian activities aimed at exacer-bating the situation in Punjab.

(b) Government have repeatedly taken up the question of anti-Indian activities by extremists in the U.K. with the Government of the United Kingdom at various levels. The British Government have repeatedly given assurances that they are making every effort to curb terrorist activity by Khalistani elements.
