(b) As the matter is linked up with the proposed comprehensive revision of the lists of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, no time limits can be specified at this stage. Any amendment in the existing lists can be done only through an Act of Parliament in view of Articles 341(2) and 342(2) of the Constitution.

Prime Minister's meeting with SC and ST M.Ps. to discuss the improvements in the Constitutional machinery under Article 338 of the Constitution.

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A majority of the Members suggested continuance of a single Commission for SCs. and STs. A few were in favour of only Commissioner for SCs. and STs.

The Government examined the matter and have taken necessary action. *Inwiau* renaming the Commission as National Commission For SCs & STs, redefining its functions to be a research body of national level, strengthening the office of the Commissioner for SCs and STs by providing two senior officers of Secretary's level to assist him and providing of disciplinary mechanism in the form of a Secretary in Cabinet Secretariat.

Deputy Minister (Welfare)'s meeting with ST Members of Parliament to discuss rehabilitation of displaced tribals,

The Members suggested formula- tion of a plicy on rehabilitation of displaced tubals

Action has already been initi- ated by the Government on this issue.

26-8-1987

Deputy Minister (Welfare)'s meeting with ST M.Ps. to discuss the administration of Scheduled areas under Tribal Sub Plan and allocation of funds for Tribal Sub Plan.

The Members emphasised the need for :
(i) proper utilisation of State Plan funds quantified and Special Cenral Assistance for the development of iribals; (ii) postingof committed officers in Tribal Sub Plan Areas;
(iii) Delegation of adequate powers to project officers of Integrated Tribal Develop- ment Projects;
(iv) Checking alienaton of Tribalslands to non-tribals; and
(v) holding meetings fo the Tribes advisory Councils in time.

All these issues are being pursued with State Govern- ments concerned on a con-tinuig basis.
