Statement-II

Recommendation of Telephone Advisory Committee and action taken

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. P.C.O's should be installed on priority in pockets with concentration of population, busy market & other important public places, libraries, dispensaries, J.J. Colonies and rural areas.
2. P.C.O's should be given to handicapped persons in more numbers, so that help could be given to them to earn better living.
3. Directory should be printed in two volumes.
4. The physical execution of work for provision of regular & temporary connections, should be expedited at field level after issue of OB's.

ACTION TAKEN

POC's are being provided in these areas on priority. However, currently there is an acute shortage of supply of CCB type public telephone instruments.

ECO's to handicapped persons are provided liberally subject to availability of suitable locations.

English and Hindi telephone directory of 1983 have been printed in two volumes each.

The monitoring of execution of orders for provision of regular and temporary connections is proposed to be computerised.
