

**Expenditure for Passenger-Oriented
Wayside Amenities along National
Highways**

1836. SHRI PAWAN KUMAR- BANSAL: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to refer to answer to Unstarred Question No. 1817 given to the Rajya Sabha on the 11th May, 1988 and state:

(a) what is the approximate cost to be incurred on the scheme for setting up passenger-oriented wayside amenities along National Highways; and

(b) what is the extent of loans and subsidy, if any, likely to be provided in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) The cost of such schemes is dependent on several factors like cost of land in the area, extent and scale of amenities proposed to be provided, the feasibility of a petrol pump forming a part of the scheme and may vary from Rs. 20 to 25 lakhs excluding the cost of petrol pump.

(b) There is no proposal to provide any loan or subsidy to private entrepreneurs.
