

(b) what steps Government propose to take to upgrade the airport at the earliest possible time, so that Boeing services can be introduced?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI MOTI LAL VORA): (a) The Defence airfield at Nasik, which is suitable for operation of turbo-prop aircraft, is considered important by the Ministry of Defence mainly for training purposes.

(b) In order to facilitate introduction of Boeing services, it is proposed to shift Indian Airlines operations to nearby Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) airfield at Ozar, subject to development of infrastructural facilities.

Vayudoot flight between Delhi and Bhatinda

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI MOTI LAL VORA): (a) and (b) Vayudoot flights were in operation between Delhi and Bhatinda from 10th August, 1987 to 11th November, 1987. Thereafter, this service was discontinued due to shortage of aircraft capacity.
