

**Declining Popularity of Nehru Light and Sound Show at Teen Murti**

1924. SHRI KRISHNA KUMAR BIRLA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the popularity of *son et lumiere*—Nehru Light and Sound show—at Teen Murti has been gradually declining since it was started in 1975;

(b) if so, whether Government have made any analysis of the reasons therefor; if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) what steps have been taken by Government to remove the deficiencies to make the show depicting tumultuous days of country's freedom struggle, with Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru as one of the main architects, popular among the tourists, both from within and outside the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI L. P. SHAHI): (a) to (c) According to Nehru Memorial Museum & Library, fully funded autonomous organisation of the Central Government, in-charge of the Sound and light show at Teen Murti, New Delhi, there has been a slight decline in the attendance of visitors to the show during the last couple of years. The Executive Council and Society of the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library have reviewed the position recently to make the show more attractive.

**1A Boeing 737 flying beyond permissible limits**

1926. SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION AND TOURISM be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Indian Airlines Boeing 737 are flying beyond the permissible limits, thereby endangering the lives of the people travelling by it;

(b) what are the routes operated by Indian Airlines Boeing flights everyday giving details of stations and flying hours; and

(c) what steps Government are taking to operate the Boeing flights within the permissible limits?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI MOTT LAL VORA): (a) Though the utilisation of aircraft in Indian Airlines' fleet has increased, this increase is without compromising on safety considerations.

(b) List of the services and the details of the stations presently operated by B-737 aircraft of Indian Airlines is attached as Statement (See below). Average daily utilisation of B-737 aircraft for schedule services is about 8.5 hours.

(c) Till such time the prescribed checks are carried out, there are no limits prescribed for the operation of Boeing aircraft. However, Indian Airlines is augmenting its fleet and has placed order for 19 A-320 Airbus aircraft for deliveries during 1989-90. Besides, they also propose to take some aircraft on lease.

केन्द्रीय माध्यमिक शिक्षा बोर्ड द्वारा प्रि-मेडिकल तथा प्रि-डेंटल परीक्षा का अंग्रेजी माध्यम में आयोजित किया जाना

श्रीमती वीणा वर्मा :

क्या स्वास्थ्य और परिवार कल्याण मंत्री यह बताने की प्रार्थना करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या यह सच है कि केन्द्रीय माध्यमिक शिक्षा बोर्ड ने आंध्र प्रदेश तथा जम्मू और काश्मीर को छोड़कर, देश के समस्त 87 मेडिकल कालेजों में 15 प्रतिशत स्थान को भरे जाने के लिये 22 मई, 1988 को पहली बार प्रि-मेडिकल तथा प्रि-डेंटल परीक्षा आयोजित की थी और उस परीक्षा का माध्यम केवल अंग्रेजी था, यदि हाँ, तो उसके क्या कारण थे ;

(ख) क्या यह सच है कि राष्ट्रीय शैक्षिक अनुसंधान और प्रशिक्षण परिषद् (एन०सी०ई०आर०टी०) द्वारा किये गये सर्वेक्षण के अनुसार इंटरमीडिएट तथा हायर सेकेंडरी स्तर पर भारतीय भाषाओं के माध्यम से अध्यापन कर रहे 92.7 प्रतिशत छात्रों के लिये प्रि-मेडिकल तथा प्रि-डेंटल परीक्षा में प्रवेश पाना कठिन है, और

(ग) देश में अंग्रेजी भाषा के माध्यम से पढ़ने वाले छात्रों की संख्या कितने प्रतिशत है ।

स्वास्थ्य और परिवार कल्याण मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (कुमारी सरोज खापड़) :  
(क) से (ग) जहाँ तक विभिन्न मेडिकल कालेजों और डेंटल कालेजों में एम०बी०बी०एस०/डी०एच० पाठ्यक्रमों में दाखिले के लिये ली जाने वाली अखिल भारतीय प्रवेश परीक्षा का सम्बन्ध है, उच्चतम न्यायालय ने इस मामले पर विचार किया है और यह निर्णय दिया है कि चूंकि एम०बी०बी०एस०/बी०डी०एच० पाठ्यक्रमों और स्नातकोत्तर पाठ्यक्रमों में शिक्षा का माध्यम अंग्रेजी है और देश भर में सम्पूर्ण चिकित्सा शिक्षा अंग्रेजी में दी जाती है, इसलिये विभिन्न क्षेत्रीय भाषाओं में अखिल भारतीय प्रवेश परीक्षा आयोजित करना व्यावहारिक रूप से सम्भव नहीं है और फिलहाल कम से कम अखिल भारतीय प्रवेश परीक्षा अंग्रेजी भाषा में ली जानी चाहिये ।
