

(b) whether there is a proposal to divide the capital into five health zones for this purpose;

(c) if so, by when the said committee would submit its report to Government; and

(d) to what extent the residents of Delhi are likely to get satisfactory health services from the hospitals?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI SAROJ KHAPARDE): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) and (d) The Committee is expected to submit its report within six weeks. The problem of over-crowding in major hospitals of Delhi will be reduced considerably and the residents of Delhi will get better specialised medical treatment facilities.

Providing of guard rails on railway bridges

1973. SHRI SUBAS MOHANTY: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state whether Government propose to provide guard rails to the bridges exceeding 500 metres in length and which do not have such guardrails to protect the de-railed bogies falling into the rivers?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MAHABIR PRASAD): Guard rails are already being provided over all open deck girder bridges.
