

Scheme for organising: beneficiaries of anti poverty programme

2147. SHRIMATI ELA RAMESH BHATT: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of beneficiaries covered so far, State-wise under the scheme of Organising Beneficiaries of Anti-poverty Programmes;

(b) the voluntary agencies which run the scheme, State-wise;

(c) whether this scheme is continuing; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI): (a) to (d) The scheme of Organisation of Beneficiaries of Anti-poverty Programmes is being implemented through Council for Advancement of People's Action and Rural Technology (ACAPART), a registered society under the aegis of Department of Rural Development, CAPART has sanctioned 517 projects till 4.7-1988 submitted by voluntary organisations in different States. On an average 50 beneficiaries are covered under each project.
