#### **Master Plan to avoid road accidents**

2587. SHRI M. VINCENT: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(Ca) whether Government have any Master Plan to avoid road accidents; and

(b) what is the number of new roads constructed and those which have been widened during the last three years, to facilitate the ever increasing traffic?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a), National Road Safety

Council in its meeting held in July, 1987 have recommended the setting up State Level Road Safety Councils, truck parking complexes along national highways, formulation of road safety schemes, identifying the specific problems, increase publicity through various medias to highlight the traffic regulations, and inclusion of suitable chapter on road safety in text books for the children, as important measures for implementation to avoid road accidents.

(b) During the last three years, so far as National Highways which come under Central Govt are concerned missing links measuring four kms. on National Highways and another 12 bye-passes have been completed. In

addition, widening of National Highways from single lane to two lanes in a length of 1026 Kms. and from two lanes to four lanes in 68 kms. have been completed.
