THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI L. P. SHAHI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) He is continuing to work at Kendriya Vidyalaya, Jorhat as per the stay order granted by the High Court, Guwahati.

(d) and (e) An enquiry has been ordered by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan in the matter. A special audit of the accounts of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Jorhat has also been ordered.

Improving condition of Railway Stations in Haryana

2647. SHRI MOHINDER SINGH LATHER: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state-

(a) whether Government have drawn up any plan to improve the condition of Railway Stations in Haryana if so, what are the details thereof;

(b) whether any Railway Station in that State is proposed to be made a modern station, if not, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to start an electric train between Delhi and Chandigarh; if so, by when it is likely to materialise?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MAHABIR PRASAD): (a) An action

plan has been drawn up to improve the condition of railway stations by remodelling/renovation/construction of station building repair/extension/rail-sing of platforms, provision of platform covers, toilet facilities drinking water facilities, etc. on a Need Based Programme, subject to availability of funds and comparative needs of different stations.

(b) Bhiwani station has been selected to be developed as a model station in Haryana.

(c) There is, at present, no proposal to electrify Delhi-Chandigarh Section.

Tourism Potential Survey of Western Coast

(a) by when the Tourism Potential survey of Western Coast is likely to be completed;

(b) whether Government propose to provide any facilities at beach resorts to encourage tourist traffic; and

(c) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI MOTI LAL VORA) (a) The Tourism Potential Survey in Western Ghats is expected to be completed by the end of the current financial year.

(b) and (c) Creation of infrastructural facilities for the development of beach tourism is a continuous process and financial assistance is provided to the State Governments for this purpose on the basis of proposals received from- them availability of funds and interse priorities.
