So far as the manning complement is concerned, the fishing vessels owners are required to adhere to the Government of India's instructions issued *vide* Gazette Notification No.340(E) dated 22nd April, 2004 which stipulate that 50% of the manning complement of deep sea fishing vessels has to be of Indian nationality. Regarding safety of life and fishing vessels at sea, a clause under DGS 'NOC' being issued stipulates that prior to their registry in India the Registrar should ensure that the imported deep sea fishing vessels are inspected thoroughly to verify their Fire Fighting Appliances and Life Saving Appliances.

#### **Non-Completion of NH-31A in Sikkim**

2528. SHRI O.T. LEPCHA: Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that National Highway No. 31A in the State of Sikkim has not so far been completed by Government;

(b) if so, the specific reasons therefor; and

(c) the time by when it is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIAPPA): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The Government has approved 2-laning with paved shoulders from Sevok to Gangtok on NH-31 A under BOT (Annuity) Scheme on 23.11.2006. Detailed Project Report and bid documents are under preparation. It is, therefore, too early to indicate time by when 2-laning of Sevok-Gangtok section of NH 31 is likely to be completed, as it would also depend on the response of bidders.
