Shortfall in Production of Foodgrain

(c) the extent to which there was shortfall in achieving the target of foodgrains production; and

(d) the steps being taken to meet the demand?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI SHYAM LAL YADAV): (a) The estimated production of various food crops in the country, Statewise, during 1987-88 is given in Statement (See below);

(b) and (c) Production of all food-grain crops was below the target during 1987-88. The overall foodgrains production during the year is provisionally estimated at 137.6 million tonnes, as against the target of 160.0 million tonnes originally fixed.

(d) In order to meet the demand, releases of foodgrains were made through public distribution system. In addition, Government have contracted for import of wheat and rice in order to replenish the buffer stocks.

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persons recommended by the National Cooperative Societies Selection Committee under the Chairmanship of Secretary to the Government of India, Department of Agriculture & Cooperation. In case the Board is superseded, the appointment is made by the Administrator, appointed by the Government,
