

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION AND TOURISM (SHRI SHIV-RAJ PATIL): (a) to (c) Indian Airlines is already operating a daily Avro flight between Bombay-Belgaum. The runway at Kolhapur airfield has fair weather landing strip. This aerodrome is being developed by the State Government for Vayudoot operations. The State Government is also constructing a terminal building with control tower. Vayudoot has plans to airlink Kolhapur depending upon the availability of adequate aircraft capacity, traffic potential and operational airfield.

**Opening of more Cancer Detection Centres in Delhi**

116. SHRI MUKHTIAR SINGH MALIK: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item which appeared in the Indian Express dated the 29th June, 1988 to the effect that there is a proposal under their consideration to set up more cancer detection centres in Delhi;

(b) if so, what is the number of such centres likely to be opened; and

(c) what are the details of funds allocated for this purpose?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI MOTI LAL VORA): ((a) and (b) Indian Cancer Society has already opened three Cancer Detection Centres in Delhi and it proposes to open two more such Centres.

(c) No specific funds have been allocated by the Government of India for this purpose.
