

Import of edible oil

478. SHRI B. SATYANARAYAN REDDY:

SHRI VITHALBHAI M. PATEL:

Will the Minister of FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to import edible oil;

(b) if so, at what rate and the quantity of edible oils likely to be imported;

(c) the quantity of edible oil imported and amount spent thereon during the last three years; and

(d) whether such imports would not effect the interests of oil seed users?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES (SHRI D. L. BAITHA): (a) and (b) Government is already importing edible oils. The quantum of edible oils being imported is decided by the Government from time to time, keeping in view various factors such as the gap between demand and supply, international prices of edible oils, availability of foreign exchange and other related factors.

(c) The quantity of edible oils imported and the amount spent thereon during the last three oil-years are as under:—
