- (b) About 3500 new telephone connections are likely to be provided during the year 1988-89.
- (c) The objective OF the Department is to meet by the end of the Seventh Plan the average registered demand upto 1.4.87 in the case of Main Automatic Exchange-I (MAX-L up o 1.4.88 in the case of MAX-II , and unto 1.4.90 in the case of MAX-IH and manual exchanges. The remaining waiting list will be cleared gradlually during the Eighth Five Year Plan.
