Seizures by the Department of Customs

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE IN THE MINISTRY FINANCE OF (SHRI AJIT PANJA): (a) During the period from January to June, 1988, goods worth Rs. 55.73 crores (provisional) were seized at the various international airports and goods worth Rs. 184.79 crores (provisional) were seized throughout the country by the Customs authorities.

(b) and (c) .1697 (provisional) persons including persons involved in major cases have been arrested by the Customs authorities during the above period.

Rehabilitation of Pick-Pockets

- (c) There is no special scheme for financing pick-pockets as such. However, all public sector banks are free to finance such rersons under the existing schemes based on their commercial judgement and on the merits of each case.
